

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Monday, April 2, 2018, 4:30 PM

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of March 20, 2018:

6. Approve Resolution 2018.04.01, State Bank of Newburg Emergency Location Agreement:
Jeff Esselmann moved to approve Resolution 2018.04.01. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.
7. Approve Pavement Markings:
Joe Gonnering explained the County's offer to mark pavement in the Town. Discussion followed regarding which roads to mark. Ed Doerr moved to request center line marking. Motion died. Ed Doerr moved to submit the pavement marking request to the County for center and edge lines within the budgeted amount. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.
8. Manure Hauling in the Township:
Ed Doerr discussed manure hauling and damage responsibility during such hauling in the Town, specifically related to a recent incident. Discussion followed. Attorney Tim Schoonenberg will investigate options and report back to the Board.

Chairman Joe Gonnering presented a CoRE Program Pipeline Safety meeting. No action.


15. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
