

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, August 7, 2018, 7:30 PM

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Deputy Clerk Lori Wanninger, Treasurer Jenny Princl, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg. Excused: Clerk Cindy Komro, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann. Chairman Gonnering invited those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of July 17, 2018:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of July 17, 2018. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WMBZ & WBKV Radio.

Ed Doerr moved to approve payment of Pitching Mounds from the Park Fund. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

Treasurer Jenny Princl reported things went well for her first time and property taxes came in and were forwarded to the County.

Deputy Clerk Lori Wanninger reported on the election and the Badger Book equipment.

Tim Schoonenberg reported on a barn wedding conditional use received a letter – we can move forward without it being a problem and can add in our own conditions.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported that as of Monday, Jeff Hartmann from DPW will be leaving the town. All culvers are installed, so they are done.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported he has been receiving calls regarding purple loosestrife, that it is a destructive species, but that most of it is on private property.

9. Payment of Bills:

Ed Doerr moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$18,589.58 and payroll totaling \$19,724.00. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

None.


12. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
