

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: September 15, 2020, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of September 1, 2020:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of September 1, 2020; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

2. Approve Minutes of Town Board Special Budget Meeting of September 11, 2020:

3. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to Washington County Daily News and WIBD Radio.

4. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Russell Krueger asked about the potential use of ATVs in the Town of Trenton. Chairman Gonnering explained that the Board considered it, and is waiting for the County to approve ATV routes, so that Town residents can travel between Town roads legally (as certain roads linking Town roads are County owned).

10. Town Fee Schedule:


