I agree to adhere to all conditions in Town of Trenton Ordinance Chapter 216, including but not limited to:

**§ 216-1. Prohibited acts.**

It is unlawful within the limits of the Town for any person to sell, expose, or offer for sale, use, keep, or discharge or to explode any firecracker, bottle rocket, cherry bomb, colored smoke bomb, blank cartridge, toy pistol or cannon in which explosives are used, contrivances using explosive caps or cartridges, display wheels, the type of balloon which requires fire underneath to propel the same, firecrackers, torpedoes, sky rockets, roman candles, aerial salutes, American or Chinese bombs or other fireworks containing any explosives or flammable compound, or any tablets or other device commonly used and sold as fireworks containing nitrates, chlorates, oxylates, sulphides of lead, barium, antimony, arsenic, mercury, nitroglycerine, phosphorus, or any compound containing any of the same or other explosives.

**§ 216-4. Bond required.**

Before any permit for the use or display of fireworks shall be granted to any applicant, the applicant shall file with the Town Clerk an indemnity bond in the name of the Town in the amount of \$1,000,000 with good and sufficient sureties for the payment of all claims that may arise by reason of injury to persons or property from the handling, use or discharge of fireworks under such permit.

**§ 216-5. Permit restrictions.**

No permit shall be granted for the display of fireworks within 50 feet of any gasoline pump, gasoline filling station or gasoline bulk station or any building in which gasoline or volatile liquid is sold in quantities in excess of one gallon.

**§ 216-6. Violations and penalties.**

Any person who shall violate any provisions of this chapter shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a forfeiture determined by reference to the schedule of deposits, bonds and fees established by the Town Board pursuant to Chapter 26, Citations, of this Code.
