

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, October 3, 2017, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Treasurer Monica Diaz. Excused: Supervisor Ed Doerr. Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of September 19, 2017:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of September 19, 2017. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WMBZ & WBKV Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

4. Review and Accept Agenda:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the agenda as presented. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

5. County Sheriff Monthly Activity Report, Matthew Dourn:

6. Approve Appointment of Wallace Lake Sanitary District Commissioner, Nathan Schaub:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve appointment of Wallace Lake Sanitary District Commissioner Nathan Schaub. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

7. Damage to Wallace Lake Road:

Joseph Gonnering reported on the damage caused on Wallace Lake Road by a manure hauler. The Town DPW performed some clean-up of the road. Gonnering suggested requesting reimbursement for the Town costs for this restoration service. Jeff Esselmann moved to request reimbursement for restoration services due to damage on Wallace Lake Road. Joe Gonnering seconded.

8. Approve Insurance Quote:

Clerk Cindy Komro reviewed the insurance renewal quote from the Horton Group. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Town insurance renewal quote. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

9. Approve Borrowing \$120,000 up to 60 Days for Trading Post Trail Reimbursement:

Joe Gonnering explained that in order to receive the TRIP Fund reimbursement for Trading Post Trail reconstruction, the expenses related to the road work must be paid. The Town must borrow the funds to pay for the final invoice from BMCI. Within 60 days, the reimbursement should be available. Jeff Esselmann moved to request a short term loan from State Bank of Newburg for \$120,000. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

10. Approve Adopt-A-Road Sign:

Clerk Cindy Komro presented the proposed Adopt-A-Road sign for the Raskiewicz Family, honoring a naval officer who died in the line of duty. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Adopt-A-Road Sign for the Raskiewicz Family. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

11. Property Tax Collection at State Bank of Newburg:

Treasurer Monica Diaz explained that the service to allow Town residents to pay their property taxes at the State Bank of Newburg costs \$200 per year. Discussion followed regarding this convenient option for property tax payments. No action taken.

12. Review 2018 Trenton Town Budget, Entertain Motion to Send Budget to Public Hearing:

Clerk Cindy Komro presented the 2018 Town Budget summary. Jeff Esselmann moved to send the 2018 Town Budget to public hearing on Tuesday, November 14 at 7:00 PM. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

13. Annexation Petitions:

14. Department Reports:

Treasurer Monica Diaz reported that the final transportation aid was received. The Town Park Playground equipment is being installed this week.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on a resident contacting the Town regarding an old cemetery on Wallace Lake Road. The County denied the proposed Sales Tax sharing. Komro and Diaz will be attending the Wisconsin Town's Association Conference on Monday and Tuesday.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering reported on the Town Park equipment installation. Gonnering reported on other DPW activity, including stump grinding.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported that the windmill that was in the ditch has been restored.

15. Payment of Bills:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$42,249.04 and payroll totaling \$14,288.54. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

None.


18. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
