

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, November 7, 2017, 7:30 PM

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of October 17, 2017:

The Petitioner has provided evidence that the lake should be named "Rathke Lake." Ed Doerr moved to withhold any recommendation and allow the Wisconsin Geographic Names Council to render a decision without the Town's recommendation. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

10. Approve Operator's License Application, Walden-A Supper Club: Angela Koller:

Applicant passed record check. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Operator's Licenses for Angela Koller. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

None.


15. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
