

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Monday, November 5, 2018, 4:00 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr (appeared after item #6), Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Treasurer Jenny Princl, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering Chairman Gonnering invited those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 4:01 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of October 16, 2018:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of October 16, 2018. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

6. Paradise Hills Revised Preliminary Plat:

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg presented the changes in the preliminary plat (minor changes in dates). The preliminary plat was approved in 2016. The bond has not yet been signed. Schoonenberg recommends approval of Developer's Agreement, subject to the corrections by the Town Attorney and the bond being signed. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Developer's Agreement, subject to the corrections by the Town Attorney and verification of the executed bond. Joe Gonnering seconded. Voting in favor: 2. Opposed: 0.

Ed Doerr moved to schedule the Town Holiday Gathering on Friday, December 21 from 12:00-3:00. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg reported on a call from the attorney representing Seoul Creek Farm regarding recent Conditional Use Permit requests.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on the Recycle Right Wisconsin Facebook page. Gonnering reported on calls from residents giving praise to the Department of Public Works employees, specially the weed cutting work done recently.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported that the weeds have stopped growing.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on the next Ag Hauling meeting on November 28 at 7:00 PM.

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$69,082.54 and payroll totaling \$16,959.50 (three-week payroll period). Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

None.


16. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
