

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, August 6, 2019, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Chairman Joseph Gonnering invited those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:32 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of July 16, 2019:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of July 16, 2019. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Town Resident Patty Doerr, 303 Washington Drive, commented on the recent news that a registered sex offender has returned to live in the Town of Trenton. Ms. Doerr expressed concern that the Town Board was not involved in the process of objecting to the placement of the individual.

6. Washington County Humane Society Municipal Cat Contract:

Chris Cowles, Board President of the Washington County Humane Society presented the proposed updated contract for feral cat control. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the new Humane Society contract for the year 2020, at \$1,976, contingent on quarterly reports on the number of cats collected from the Town. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

7. Milwaukee Metropolitan Sewerage District:

Karen Nenahlo from MMSD presented the Nonpoint Source Watershed Restoration Plan Project for Villages of Newburg & Fredonia.

8. Vivian Stockhausen Park Playground Equipment Update:

Chairman Joe Gonnering updated the Board on the Vivian Stockhausen Park Playground Equipment installation.

9. Telecommunications Analysis:

Chairman Joe Gonnering presented the proposal by Telecomm, to review the Town's phone and cable services. No action.

10. Badger Book Purchase:

Clerk Cindy Komro explained the need for two additional Badger Book electronic voting machines, the cost of which is in the 2019 budget. Ed Doerr moved to approve the purchase of two additional Badger Books. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Clerk Cindy Komro recommended setting up a meeting to discuss the 2020 Town budget. Jeff Esselmann moved to schedule a special budget meeting for 6:00 PM on Tuesday, August 20. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the July bank statement reconciliations. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the requests from the 2020 Census Partnership Group. Town Crier Articles are needed for the Fall Town Crier.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on tree trimming in the Town.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on the weed growth in the Town.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on communication from GMAR (Greater Milwaukee Area Realtors), asking the Town to refrain from building four-family buildings in the Town. Gonnering reported on a recent City of West Bend Plan Commission meeting. Gonnering reported on road work in the Town.

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$36,882.38. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

None.


18. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
