

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, August 20, 2019, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering invited those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of August 6, 2019:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of August 6, 2019. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, stating that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Town Resident Dennis Kay asked whether the request for cost for Paradise Drive paving was satisfied. The cost for Paradise Drive road work is estimated at \$199,311.74. Kay also asked about the culvert requirements for homes in the Paradise Hills Subdivision. Gonnering explained that the Subdivision Plat was accepted by the Plan Commission and Town Board.

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies presented the final plat for Paradise Hills Subdivision. Plan Commission recommends approval. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the final plat presented for Paradise Hills Subdivision. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

7. Ordinance Z2019-08-01, Comprehensive Plan Amendment with Accompanying Rezoning, James Schmidt, South Church Road:

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies presented Ordinance Z2019-08-01. Plan Commission recommends approval. Ed Doerr moved to approve Ordinance Z2019-08-01. Jeff Esselmann seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

8. Certified Survey Map Recommendation, James Schmidt, South Church Road:

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies explained the few corrections needed. Plan Commission recommends approval. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the CSM for James Schmidt, South Church Road. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

9. Telecommunications Analysis:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the contract. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

10. 2020 Town Budget Update:

Joe Gonnering reviewed the 2020 Town budget process, and mentioned the possibility of putting money aside for a mower to be used for grass cutting, in lieu of contracting those services. Jeff Esselmann moved to set a special Budget Meeting for 6:30 on Tuesday, September 3. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies reported on a resident complaining about junk vehicles on a property on Wallace Lake Road.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the requests from the 2020 Census Partnership Group.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg had nothing to report.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on the TRIP Fund reimbursement for Paradise Drive.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on a complaint about purple loose strife, an invasive weed species, in the Town.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reminded the Board to convene at 8:00 AM on Wednesday, August 21, for the Annual Road Tour. Gonnering reported on the DPW activity, specifically park maintenance and improvement, and road work on South Oak Road. Gonnering reported on complaints of excessive gunshots on a nearby property.


19. Take Action as a Result of Closed Session:
