

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: Tuesday, September 3, 2019, 7:30 PM

Chairman Joseph Gonnering invited those in attendance to join in reciting the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of August 20, 2019:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the Minutes of the Town Board Meeting of August 20, 2019. Ed Doerr seconded. Voting in favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Clerk Cindy Komro reported that the Town Crier is finished and was sent for distribution. Komro reminded the Board that the Trenton electronic waste event is on Saturday, September 7 from 8:00-noon at Advanced Disposal, 803 River Road.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on the purple loosestrife in the Town, and the attempts to eradicate it.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on road work in the Town.

None.


15. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
