

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: May 5, 2020, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering dispenses with the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:32 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of April 21, 2020:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of April 21, 2020, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Gary Lauters, 1145 E Newark Drive, commented that the section marker on Newark and Church is exposed in the middle of the road, causing a hazardous condition.
Tim Wollack, 2120 Glenway Drive, ask whether speed bumps can be installed on Glenway, due to the daily high speed traffic. Joe Gonnering explained that speed bumps have not been allowed in the past, due to difficulty of snowplowing and maintenance.

Chairman Joe Gonnering presented the Bond Agreement for Coventry Meadows. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the agreement, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

8. Alcohol Beverage License Fees:

Clerk Cindy Komro explained that Slinger has waived a portion of their alcohol beverage license fees for 2020. No action.

9. Approve Plan Commission Appointment (Alternate) for three-year term, 4/1/2020-3/31/2023:

Jeff Esselmann reported on culverts in the Town, and on the proposed hard cider business.


17. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
