

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: June 2, 2020, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of May 19, 2020:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of May 19, 2020, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Gary Staral, 6330 Scenic Drive East, asked about his zoning and how it relates to building a garage on his property. Chairman Joseph Gonnering commented that the Plan Commission must consider his proposal first.

4. Review and Accept Agenda:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the agenda as presented, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

5. May Bank Statement Reconciliations:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the May bank statement reconciliations, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

6. Ordinance 2020.05.01, Boats and Boating:

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg presented the proposed ordinance. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve Ordinance 2020.05.01, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

7. Ordinance 2020.06.01, Concrete Driveways:

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg discussed proposed changes to the existing driveway ordinance. Discussion followed regarding the permit application fee and the concerns with concrete driveways. Joe Gonnering moved to table further discussion of this issue to the first meeting in July, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

8. Posting of No Parking Sign on Sand Drive and Walsh Acres:

Chairman Joseph Gonnering reminded the Board about the parking issues on the corner lot of Sand Drive and Walsh Acres. Discussion followed. No action.

9. Athletic Field Use:

Clerk Cindy Komro explained that several groups have asked to use the Town Athletic fields for tournaments and games. Discussion followed regarding the insurance company's recommendation. Ed Doerr moved to deny access to the Town Park for organized sports, following the CDC's guidelines for COVID-19, and to post proper notices stating that, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

10. Town Mobile Phones:

Clerk Cindy Komro explained the concerns with using personal mobile phones for Town business. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve purchase of a mobile phone for the Clerk, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies reported on the activity in the Building and Zoning Departments.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on a request by Nelson Tree to allow parking of their vehicles while they are working in the area for the next few weeks. Komro reported on a resident call regarding a fox and kits resident under her shed. Komro reported on a resident concern about We Energies installing smart meters at her residence. Komro reminded the Board that the June 16 meeting is at 7:00, followed by the Annual Town meeting at 8:00 PM.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg had nothing to report.

Jeff Esselmann reported that a small section of Poplar Road needs cold patch.

Ed Doerr reported on the review of Paradise Drive. Doerr reported on the Farmington meeting regarding the sharing of responsibility for Newark Drive.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on road work and ditching in the Town.

13. Payment of Bills:

Ed Doerr moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$31,228.16, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

None.


16. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
