

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: July 7, 2020, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:32 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of June 16, 2020:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of June 16, 2020, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Tony Thoma asked about the progress on concrete driveways. The Board is still working through the issue.

4. Review and Accept Agenda:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the agenda as presented, and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

5. Present Police Service Awards:

6. June Bank Statement Reconciliations:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the June bank statement reconciliations and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

7. Waiver of Culvert Requirements, Randy Czarnecki, 713 Washington Drive:

Chairman Joseph Gonnering explained the request for waiver of the culvert requirement. Jeff Esselmann moved to waive the culvert requirement for 713 Washington Drive as it does not affect any local drainage and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

8. Newark Drive Construction Update:

Ed Doerr reported on the Newark Drive Construction, the recent road visit to assess what is needed. Doerr presented Graef's report, with several options. Ed Doerr moved to proceed with the following on Newark Drive: 1) locate the existing right of way on both sides of the road at approximately 100 foot intervals and 2) have a contractor start grading where driveway culverts and utility conflicts are not an issue, the complete a partial design of remaining areas (includes utility coordination and agency approvals), at a cost of \$8,000 and \$30,000, respectively (options 1 and 4 on Graef's report) and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

9. Paradise Drive

Ed Doerr reported on Paradise Drive. Ed Doerr moved to approve replacement of the culvert at 1291 Paradise Dr, with a 15 inch, 20 foot culvert, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

10. Annexation Petitions:

11. Department Reports:

Zoning Administrator Barbara Davies reported on calls from residents asking about having chickens on properties less than three acres, which is not allowed by current Town ordinances. Davies

reported on a concrete driveway that was installed at 1859 Hunter's Grove. Davies reported on general activity in the Building and Zoning Departments.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the recent changes to Election processes. Komro reported on the upcoming training throughout the week of July 14, during which the Town will have limited office hours.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg reported on the Police Service Awards, which will be presented at the July 21 meeting.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on upcoming road work in the Town.

Supervisor Ed Doerr commented on the resident requests to have chickens on smaller lots. Doerr asked about the Badke notice for the Paradise Drive road review meeting.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on the DPW activity in the Town, specifically ditching and culvert installation.

12. Payment of Bills:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$53,180.32 and Ed Doerr seconded. In favor: 3. Opposed: 0.

None.


15. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Already Pending Before the Town Board:
