

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: August 4, 2020, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of July 21, 2020:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of July 21, 2020, and Ed Doerr seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Boards and sent to West Bend Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

4. Review and Accept Agenda:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the agenda, moving #11, Cement Driveways, to #5; Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

5. Cement Driveways:

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg presented Ordinance 2020.08.01, Amendment to Driveway Installation Requirements Regarding Concrete Driveways, changing the damages for violation from "double" to "triple" permit fees. Jeff Esselmann moved to approve Ordinance 2020.08.01 and Ed Doerr seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

6. Reinstate August 18 Town Board Meeting to Tuesday at 7:30 PM, No Conflict with Election:

Ed Doerr moved to reinstate August 18 Town Board meeting to Tuesday, August 18 at 7:30 PM, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

7. Police First Report of Injury Form:

8. July Bank Statement Reconciliations:

Ed Doerr moved to approve the July bank statement reconciliations, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

9. Wallace Lake Road Culvert:

Chairman Joseph Gonnering reported that the Wallace Lake Road culverts have been installed. Ed Doerr moved to approve lowering one end of the culvert, as recommended by Town engineer Burt Naumann; Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

10. Newark Drive Update:

Ed Doerr updated the Board on the Newark Drive construction.

11. Paradise Drive Culvert Update:

Ed Doerr updated the Board on the Paradise Drive culvert installation at the Smith residence.

12. Purchase of Town Land for Park Purposes:

Joe Gonnering reported on Town land being offered for sale, listed at \$34,900, which could be used as additional park. No action.

13. Approve Election Inspector Appointments: Albert Jung, Kailyn Komro, Michael Komro, Cindy Spangenberg:

Ed Doerr moved to approve appointments of the listed individuals as Election Inspectors, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

14. Athletic Fields Use:

Ed Doerr moved to prohibit formal Athletic activities in the Town Park until March 31, 2021, and Jeff Esselmann seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

15. Special Budget Meetings:

Discussion ensued regarding scheduling special meetings to discuss the 2021 Town budget.

16. Annexation Petitions:

17. Department Reports:

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the upcoming August 11 Election. Komro asked for newsletter articles for the Fall Town Crier.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg had nothing to report.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reminded everyone that the Electronic Waste event is in September. Esselmann reported on a non-profit group in West Bend interested in getting playground equipment for "all abilities" in the West Bend area.

Supervisor Ed Doerr had nothing to report. Doerr commented that Building Inspector Walt Groteleuschen may need assistance, as he is very busy.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on road repair and culvert activity in the Public Works Department.

18. Payment of Bills:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$18,657.09 and Ed Doerr seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

None.


21. Ordinances, Resolutions, Reports or Recommendations Pending Before the Town Board:
