

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: February 2, 2021, 7:30 PM

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve attendance at the virtual/remote Clerk & Treasurers Institute (Second Year) for Cindy Komro and Nicole Cozzuli-Meer; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion passed 3-0.

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the upcoming Spring Primary Election.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported that he received his first COVID vaccination. Esselmann recommended that the DPW remove the large block of snow hanging precariously from the roof of the building near the entrance.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported that he received his first COVID vaccination. Doerr reported on a few resident calls regarding snowplowing.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on DPW activity, including mailbox damage from snow plowing.


13. Payment of Bills and Property Tax Refunds:
