

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: April 5, 5:00 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro, Attorney Tim Schoonenberg. Excused: Supervisor Ed Doerr

Chairman Joseph Gonnering dispensed with the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 5:00 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of March 16, 2021:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of March 16, 2021; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

6. Wallace Lake Road:

Joe Gonnering recommended the Board visit Wallace Lake Road to view progress.

7. Culvert Waiver Request, 1635 Paradise Drive:

Jeff Esselmann moved to deny the culvert waiver request at 1635 Paradise Drive; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

8. Election Inspector Appointment: Shelbie Proudfoot:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the appointment of Shelbie Proudfoot to Election Inspector; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

9. Wisconsin DOT Salt Agreement:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve participation in the 2021-2022 Wisconsin DOT Salt Agreement; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

10. Road Repair Bid Award: 2021 Crack Filling and Crack Sealing:

Jeff Esselmann moved to award the Crack Filling bid to Thunder Road for \$14,436.00 as per bid. Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

11. Road Repair Bid Award: 2021 Chipsealing:

Jeff Esselmann moved to award bid for Chipsealing on Sand Drive (Cty Hwy I to Fire #5743), Walsh Acres, and Holly Lane to Scott Construction for a total of \$29,796.00. Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

12. Road Repair Bid Award: 2021 Hot Mix Asphalt, Pulverize, Grade and Roll, Gravel:

Jeff Esselmann moved to award the bid as follows: N Church – Wallace Lake to Newark Dr and Shady Lane – Village Limits to Fire #7062 to Kartechner Brothers for \$45,298.50 and \$39,881.50, respectively, and Paradise Drive – Sand Drive to City Limits to Payne & Dolan for \$61,600.00, and an additional \$7,000 for shouldering, as per adjusted bid. Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

13. Road Repair Bid Award: 2021 Backhoe:

Jeff Esselmann moved to award the bid for backhoe work to BNCI Construction at \$175.00 per hour; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

14. Pavement Marking 2021:

Joe Gonnering discussed possible pavement marking work to perform in 2021. Jeff Esselmann moved to hire Washington County Highway Department to perform centerline and edge line pavement marking work on approximately 7.5 miles of road in the Town of Trenton; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 2-0.

15. Department Reports:

Clerk Cindy Komro reported on the Spring Election, and reminded the Board that the next meeting is on Tuesday, April 20 at 7:00 PM, followed by the Annual Town Meeting at 8:00 PM. The Town Crier is ready to print. An article was added addressing the Town revaluation and change in assessments.

Attorney Tim Schoonenberg reported on progress of enforcement of the Wallace Lake property. Schoonenberg also reported on the Group Home properties in the Town.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann reported on calls from residents.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on calls from residents, specifically on the change in assessments from the revaluation.

16. Payment of Bills:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve payment of bills totaling \$43,263.99; Joe Gonnering seconded. Motion passed 3-0.
