

Minutes from the Town of Trenton Town Board Meeting

Date and Time: July 6, 2021, 7:30 PM

Location: Town of Trenton Town Hall, 1071 Highway 33 East, West Bend, WI 53095

Present: Chairman Joseph Gonnering, Supervisor Ed Doerr, Supervisor Jeff Esselmann, Clerk Cindy Komro.

Chairman Joseph Gonnering asked those in attendance to stand and recite the Pledge of Allegiance. Gonnering called the Meeting to order at 7:30 P.M.

1. Approve Minutes of Town Board Meeting of June 15, 2021:

Jeff Esselmann moved to approve the minutes of the Town Board meeting of June 15, 2021; Ed Doerr seconded. Motion carried 3-0.

2. Affidavit of Posting:

Chairman Gonnering read the affidavit of posting, that notice was properly posted prior to the meeting on the Town Bulletin Board and the Town official website and was also sent to the Washington County Daily News and WIBD Radio.

3. Comments and Questions from the Audience:

Clerk Cindy Komro reported that the Town Hall will be closed for general office hours the week of July 12, for the Clerks and Treasurers Institute training. Building Inspector and Zoning Administrator hours will be as usual.

Supervisor Jeff Esselmann asked about the mileage expense in the bills to be approved. Clerk Cindy Komro explained that the mileage expense reimbursement requests relate to regular visits to the Post Office, Bank and Town bulletin boards, which are submitted quarterly. Esselmann also reported on an article in the newspaper regarding a Town driveway/culvert issue. Esselmann asked about the receipts for the Town's metal recycling.

Supervisor Ed Doerr reported on the weed growth in the Town and reported on a resident request for a berm. Doerr asked about a portion of Church Road that is posted as private.

Chairman Joe Gonnering reported on a letter sent to a resident addressing a zoning issue. Gonnering reported on repairs needed on the Town's tractor. Gonnering reported on the West Bend Planning Commission agenda.


13. Payment of Bills:
